

Call to Confession

Leader: Friends, the Spirit who gives wisdom and understanding also shines light on what is true. When we resist God’s work—when we hide our gifts, compare ourselves to others, or use our strengths for ourselves instead of the common good—we miss the way of Christ. Trusting God’s mercy, and believing that God can realign and renew us, let us confess our sin together.

Corporate Prayer of Confession

All: Gracious God, you have poured out your Spirit on your people and called us one body in Christ. Yet we confess we often live as if we stand alone. We compare our gifts, dismiss what you have placed in us, or cling to control instead of trusting your Spirit. We withhold our time and love when service feels inconvenient, and we ignore the needs of neighbors you place before us. Forgive us for the ways we have failed to

seek the common good. Realign our hearts with Jesus, our Lord. Renew in us the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, counsel and courage, so that we may serve with joy, speak with love, and build up your church. In Christ’s name we pray. Amen.

Leader: Let us take a moment for silent confession and personal reflection.

Assurance of Pardon

Leader: Hear the good news: the same Spirit who convicts us does not abandon us—He restores us. In Jesus Christ, God meets us with mercy, not shame; with forgiveness, not condemnation. By the Spirit, our hearts are realigned, our lives are made new, and our gifts are given back to us for the common good. In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven.
