Call to Confession

Leader: On the mountain, the disciples caught a glimpse of Jesus’ glory—and they fell down in fear. In the presence of the Holy One, we also see more clearly: our pride, our distractions, our resistance to listening, and our reluctance to be changed. Yet the God who is holy also comes near with mercy and invitation. Trusting in God’s grace, let us confess our sin together.

Corporate Prayer of Confession

All: Holy God, you are great and you are holy. We confess we often live as if you are not. We do not listen well to your Son. We let fear lead, not faith. We choose comfort over obedience, and we turn from justice and loving our neighbor. Gracious God, have mercy on us. Forgive us our sins, lift us up into your presence, and change us — so that we may follow Jesus from the mountain into our daily life.

In Christ’s name we pray. Amen.

Leader: Let us take a moment for silent confession and personal reflection.

Assurance of Pardon

Leader: Hear the good news: the Holy One who reigns in glory is also rich in mercy. In Jesus Christ, we are forgiven, lifted up, and made new.

So do not be afraid — because the Jesus who shines with glory also comes close with mercy. Receive God’s grace today: you are forgiven, you are held, and you are being made new. And walk in the light of Christ — listening to him, choosing what is right, and carrying his peace into the world.

All: Thanks be to God. Amen.
